Day 1 :

Designed by the famous Tom Morris, this is an undulating course similar in characteristics to the Old Course;

Day 2 :

Gleneagles Kings.

Championship Heathland course with stunning views which has hosted both UK and overseas Championship Events.

Day 3 :

Carnoustie Championship;

16th century East coastal open championship links course some 25 miles from St Andrews; Carnoustie arguably possesses the toughest finishing holes in Championship golf
The Barry Burn meanders treacherously across the final two holes which measure 886 yards while each plays to a par of four.

Day 4 :

Castle Course St Andrews

The Castle Course is the seventh course at the Home of Golf, capping an unparalleled history dating back six centuries to when the game was first played on the Old Course. Recognised by Travel and Leisure Golf as the New Course of the Year 2008: Set on a dramatic cliff-top location with stunning views over St Andrews Bay and out to the North Sea; The Castle Course combines breathtaking beauty with wonderful golf.
